Windscoop with mosquito net

Cabin Breeze easy set up windscoop with build in mosquito net. Set up with only a halyard. A steel frame keeps the scoop inside the boat and a halyard tightens the windscoop up. Get a breeze inside the boat to bring down inside temperature.


Windscoop with mosquito net

Cabin Breeze

Smart and practical windscoop with bug screen for standard hatches. Easy to setup with a spinnaker halyard. The windscoop has a large frame that presses against the hatch inner frame. The stretch from the halyard keeps the windscoop in place. This makes the windscoop so easy to setup that it can be done under a minute. Compare with other competitive brands on the market that take long time to assemble and have several lines on deck that you need to tie. Cabin Breeze keeps the shape even in light winds. In winds over 7-10 m/s we recommend to take it down since it will be too much wind inside the boat.


The large steel spring has a size of over 650x650 mm which means it can be used on square hatches with an opening of up to 520x520 mm (and also smaller sizes). The overlap from the larger steel spring keeps it closed to the inner boat ceiling and the scope is designed with a ~10 cm inner collar that keeps it in the middle of the hatch. The collar will prevent the windscoop from moving around and stop a corner from popping out. Can be set up on almost every square hatch, deep hatches or flushed hatches.

The windscoop is built with a pop-up function which means it also can be folded down to 1/3 of the size when stored and not in use. The built-in bug screen / mosquito net makes the windscoop unique on the boat market. Who wants a windscoop that pushes in everything flying in the wind.

How to set up




1 Unfold the windscoop.
Connect the bar inside the fabric.

2 Put bottom inside. Make sure it's
placed in the center of the hatch.


3 Attach the ring to halyard.
Lift the halyard.


How to take down and store




Loosen the halyard and take down the windscoop.




Take apart the stick on the inside




Grab the net with two hands and pull out a little. It will be easier to twist.




Twist




Pull hands together




You should now have 3 "rings". Wrap the scoop around the net.



Wrap around the folded net



Stick diagonal across the net



Store the windscoop in bag.
